## SUB: APPOINTMENT OF CERTIFICATION AGENCY FOR RE-CERTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AS PER ISO 14001:2015 AND QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AS PER ISO 9001:2015

Sealed offers are invited to appoint a Certification Agency for recertification of Environment Management System as per ISO 14001:2015 and Quality Management System as per ISO 9001:2015 of Punjab Alkalies & Chemicals Ltd. under the RVA Accreditation scheme, on the following terms & conditions:

### 1. SCOPE OF WORK:

Punjab Alkalies & Chemicals Ltd. (PACL), a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 with its Registered office at Chandigarh and Works at Naya Nangal, Distt. Ropar (Punjab) is having an Industrial License for manufacturing of the following items:

- i) Caustic Soda Lye
- ii) Caustic Soda Flake
- iii) Chlorine Gas
- iv) Liquid Chlorine
- v) Hydrochloric Acid
- vi) Calcium Hypochlorite (Bleach Liquor)
- vii) Sodium Hypochlorite (Bleach Liquor)
- viii) Hydrogen Gas
- ix) Spent Sulphuric Acid

PACL is manufacturing the above products in its Plants at Naya Nangal namely Unit-I & Unit-II located inside the same premises having production capacity of 100 TPD and 200 TPD respectively of Caustic Soda Lye by using membrane Cell technology. Hydro static testing of Chlorine Tonners is also carried out in our Plant premises.

PACL has established its Environment Management System (EMS) at its Plant at Naya Nangal, Distt. Ropar (Punjab) and the same has been certified by DNV for ISO:14001:2004 w.e.f. 21.7.2005 and the Certificate is valid till 20.07.2017. The Quality Management System (QMS) has been certified by DNV for ISO 9001:2008 w.e.f. 8.11.1996 and is valid upto 20.07.2017.

PACL is interested to get its EMS and QMS audited and recertified under the RVA Accreditation Scheme.

2. The scope of work for recertification of Environment Management System of PACL for ISO 14001:2015 and Quality Management System for ISO 9001:2015 under RVC Accreditation Scheme or under Quality Council of India Accredited Scheme includes the following:

### CERTIFICATION ASSESSMENT:

In this connection, Agency will carry out the following activities:

- a) Initial Audit (Re-certification Audit) to verify implementation of Environment Management System and Quality Management System at our Works at Naya Nangal.
- b) Recommendation for continuation of certification after successful completion of the initial audit.
- c) Issue of the certificates in continuation of the present certificates within 4 (Four) weeks of satisfactory completion of the initial audit.

3. SURVEILLANCE PROGRAMME (PERIODIC AUDIT):

In this connection, Agency will audit for Certified Environment Management System and Quality Management System once in a year (total two audits) during the validity period of the certificate in order to maintain the validity of the above certificates.

4. TIME FRAME:

The initial audit (recertification audit) will be conducted by Agency within 4 weeks of the issue of Work Order.

5. FEE:

Kindly quote your competitive charges.

The payment shall be made within 30 days from the date of receipt of your bill. The periodical audit visit on yearly basis in the financial year 2018-19 & 2019-20 will be required to verify maintenance of the EMS & QMS Systems throughout the certification's validity period during three years.

6. SERVICE & OTHER TAXES:

Service Tax as applicable shall be paid extra, at actual. Any Central/State Govt. taxes, applicable at prevailing time, will be paid by PACL at actual.

8. ARBITRATION:

In all cases of dispute or disagreement between Punjab Alkalies & Chemicals Limited & the party hereto as to any matter arising out of or relating to this Work Order whether such dispute or disagreement shall arise during the continuance of this Work Order regarding interpretation of this Work Order or any Clause or Clauses thereof or upon or after the termination hereof and provided no understanding between the parties can be reached for the settlement of the difference shall be referred to the sole arbitrator, the Managing Director of Punjab Alkalies & Chemicals Limited or any other officer appointed by him on his behalf, in accordance with the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any Statutory modifications or substitute thereof and all the provisions of that Act, so far as are applicable or of any of them for the time being in force shall apply to every reference hereunder.

The award given by such Arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding upon the parties to this Work Order. The Arbitrator may from time to time, with the consent of parties, enlarge the time for making or publishing the award. The arbitration proceedings shall be held at Chandigarh.

Notwithstanding any pending reference to arbitration both parties shall proceed with the execution of their commitments, under the Work Order until the arbitration award is known, unless the question of such continuance is a subject matter of such proceedings.


9. LAW AND ITS JURISIDITION:

The contract shall be governed by the laws of Govt. of India in force from time to time and shall be deemed to have been concluded in the Union Territory of Chandigarh. All suits and proceedings shall be subject to jurisdiction of the courts at Chandigarh only.
